Below is a pamphlet to print or email to potential sponsors that explains this program as well as tips for writing an email or letter to potential sponsors.

TIPS FOR WRITING A SPONSOR LETTER

A few tips to writing a letter to relatives, family friends, your church congregation & church leaders, and others to ask for Adopt-A-Staff sponsorships.

- Tell your story (briefly). If your audience doesn't know you well, introduce yourself, your role at Beaver Camp (counselor, TLT, etc), and explain in just a few sentences how Beaver Camp has helped you grow over the years you've attended.
- If your audience isn't very familiar with Beaver Camp, explain what it is.
- If you have a story of how you've impacted a kid at camp, this is a great time to explain that. If you don't have a specific example, still explain camp's impact on kids.
- What is your specific goal with fundraising? Are you trying to work in ministry, while also attending college or high school? Are you trying to impact kids, and grow your leadership, but you have other obligations that make it difficult to work through college? You don't need a sob story, just a "you're helping me do ministry and go to college."
- Make a SPECIFIC request. Explain that you are trying to raise additional support through the Adopt-A-Staff program, to supplement the ministry salary offered at Beaver Camp. The best way for them to support you is by: explain the steps to donating to your Adopt-A-Staff. Make sure their instructions on how to give to you are clear, and concise.
- End by thanking them for helping you in your ministry. Thank them in advance for their donation.
- Personalize the letter. It's easy to hit send on an email to your parents' contact list of 100 people, but it's more difficult to write each name out and send individual emails, or print/write out individual letters to each person. It's more intentional, more personal. You're asking them to be a part of your ministry. It should be personal!
- If you've worked at camp before, I strongly recommend attaching a photo of you working with campers in the past. If not, perhaps a photo of you as a camper could be included. If you don't know how to find a photo from a previous summer, reach out to year-round staff at camp!

SPONSOR FORM AND RESPONSE

The sponsor may complete the response form and return it to Beaver Camp with their contribution. At a minimum, the sponsor MUST INCLUDE YOUR NAME on the check or, if giving online, choose "Other" under designation and then email our office with your name and the amount they are giving. This will help ensure donations get to you!

By participating in the adopt a staff program you acknowledge that in the event that you do not complete your term of service, the unused balance of sponsored funds will be transferred to our campership fund.

We are grateful for your willingness to serve in camping ministry this summer! We trust you will receive God's blessing as you serve and that those you serve may experience His presence through you. We hope you will be successful in arranging for sponsors and that this program will be beneficial to you in meeting your college expenses.

In the event that the individual does not complete the term of their contract, the donation will be transferred to our campership fund. To take part in this ministry, simply complete the attached form and return it with your contribution.
